The Board of Education of the Wheelersburg Local School District met on Friday, July 10, 2015 at the Board of Education Office.

ROLL CALL

The President called the meeting to order and the following members answered to roll call—Donna Cunningham-present; Jonathan Eaton-present; Ben Gill-present; Scott Jolly-present; Matthew Miller-present.

PUBLIC HEARING

Notice was given under Section 3307.353 of the Ohio Revised Code and published in the local newspaper that Barry Spradlin will be retiring under the State Teachers Retirement System of Ohio and is seeking employment with this Board thereafter in the same position (Teacher) he held prior to retirement. The Board asked for comments from the public during this Hearing. None was offered.
