The Board of Education of the Wheelersburg Local School District met at the Board of Education Office at 7:30 a.m.

In view of the current public health crisis due to COVID-19, the Wheelersburg Local Board of Education has chosen to rely upon Ohio Attorney General Dave Yost's letter of March 13, 2020, that "Under this very limited fact pattern, there may be a basis for local public bodies to use electronic means to meet and comply with the law." This privilege has been extended via Ohio HB 404.
